

Magento 1 Deprecation.

Magento will <u>officially deprecate</u> Magento 1 for all Commerce and Open Source versions of Magento 1 on June 30, 2020. In addition to the platform deprecation, the <u>Magento Marketplace</u> will no longer accept or host Magento 1 plugins by July 7, 2020 and Klarna Checkout and Klarna Payments M1 plugins will be removed.

What does this mean for merchants on Magento 1?

Magento will no longer release updates to the Magento 1 platform including security patches. This means merchants are at risk of security breaches and no longer being compliant with the <u>Payment Card Industry Data Security Standards (PCI DSS)</u>.

What does Klarna recommend?

Klarna recommends merchants on Magento 1 to upgrade their site to Magento 2 or re-platform to another supported ecommerce platform. How does Klarna plan to support Magento 1 going forward?

Officially, Klarna will no longer support Magento 1 or the Magento 1 Klarna Plugins. The Klarna team will no longer make updates to the Magento 1 plugins nor accept support requests regarding the plugins to magento@klarna.com. However, the plugins are available on GitHub under the Klarna organization. All merchant's will assume the full risk and responsibility of the ongoing updates necessary to ensure their sites are processing securely with Klarna.

Klarna's Magento 1 plugins for Klarna Checkout and Klarna Payments are offered as-is. With the deprecation of Magento 1 by Magento, An Adobe Company, Klarna will no longer be maintaining the Magento 1 plugins. This includes the following:

- No feature requests for updated Klarna services will be completed
- No pull requests will be accepted
- No issues to code will be accepted
- · Support requests to magento@klarna.com will receive a response in regards to the plugins no longer being supported.
